Fire Warden Annual Report

January 1, 2018 – December 31, 2018

I. EMERGENCY INCIDENTS

- Between January 1, 2018 December 31, 2018, there were a total of 182 emergency responses:
 - Pinedale 60
 - Big Piney/Marbleton 46
 - Bondurant 23
 - Boulder 31
 - Daniel 17
 - Kendall Valley 5
- Our average turn-out time in 2018 was 10 minutes and 69 seconds.

II. FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

• There were (6) six fire investigations between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018.

III. FIRE PREVENTION

- SMOKE DETECTOR PROGRAM
 - 104 smoke detectors were installed throughout Sublette County in 2018.
 - SLASH PILES BURNED One (1)
 - FIRE WISE TRAINING Three days
 - FIRE WISE MEETINGS Nineteen (19)
 - **COMMUNITY EDUCATION EVENTS** Seventeen (17)

IV. TRAINING

- FIRE TRAINING
 - 43 State Issued Structure Training Qualifications were issued in 2018.
 - 17 Wildland Certifications were issued in 2018.
 - 11 EMT Certifications were issued to firefighters in 2018.
 - 280 classes were offered, with a total of 1962:35 class hours. 2251 firefighters attended with a total of 8109:15-man hours.

V. HEALTH & SAFETY

- Firefighters are up to date with CPR and First Aid.
- Completed 81 physicals and 85 stress tests in 2018.
- EVAC plans have been created for the Sublette Center, Aspen Grove, and The Pioneer Center.

VI. HOURS SPENT IN 2017

- The firefighters donated 1,750.25 volunteer hours throughout the County and community.
- Firefighters spent 2,873:12 hours with Alarm responses.
- Training hours for firefighters totaled 8081:45 hours.

VII. Federal Fires

- 22 Deployments to Federal Fires outside of Sublette County.
- 41 SCUF Firefighters were deployed on the Roosevelt Fire.
- \$240,626.53 was paid to firefighters from Federal Fires (not including Roosevelt). This has been reimbursed to Sublette County.
- \$183,592.33 was paid to firefighters from the Roosevelt Fire. This will be reimbursed to Sublette County.
- Approximately \$121,823.00 for Fire Income to County for future Wildland apparatus purchase.






